These important masterworks for the viola that show this Norwegian violist's versatility and virtuosity. The Ysaÿe has not been recorded before and the Barratt-Due was commissioned specially for Eivind (by the BBC when he was a New Generation Artist) and premiered at the Edinburgh Festival. Eivind is the first violist to be signed by Rubicon and plays the G.B.Guadagnini 'ex-Vieuxtemps' viola 1768 that Henry Vieuxtemps himself played.
